


Transportation is consistently the most reported barrier to consistent participation.

Did you know? The average child in the United States today spends less than three years playing a sport, quitting by age 11. Kids from lower-income homes participate less often.



83% of Soccer Without Borders participants graduated from high school...

...compared to 60% for English language learners in the same districts.

YOUTH SURVEY RESULTS

ACADEMIC ADVANCEMENT

100% of SWB female seniors graduated from high school.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

91% of respondents reported that every day, they work hard to reach their goals.

LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

91% of respondents reported that they feel comfortable using English at SWB.

SOCIAL CAPITAL

93% of SWB respondents reported feeling safe at SWB and 95% trust their coach in this program.

HEALTHY LIFESTYLES

92% of respondents reported that the Soccer Without Borders program helped them to be healthy.
